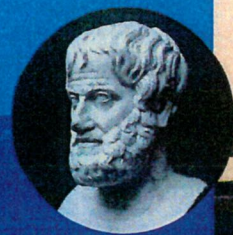

CLASSICAL EDUCATION

GRAMMAR

FOUNDATION OF FACTS
(K-6th Grade)

The Trivium begins with the **Grammar** phase. At this developmental stage children naturally enjoy learning new information and have an incredible ability to memorize and retain this information. During this phase, children build an extensive knowledge base of foundational facts, including phonics, grammatical structures, Latin, plant and animal classifications, dates, events, geography, and mathematical language and structure.



LOGIC

APPLICATION OF KNOWLEDGE
(7th-9th Grades)

In the **Logic** phase students begin to connect both context and purpose to the information they have mastered in the Grammar phase. Through the study of logic, they learn the fundamentals of critical thinking, and they begin to see all subjects as an integrated whole. Approaching learning from a biblical worldview, students discern truth from error in every subject. Students are encouraged to explore and question what they have learned so they will be able to confidently present and defend the truth as they move into the Rhetoric phase.



RHETORIC

EXPRESSION AND INVENTION
(10th-12th Grades)

Students in the **Rhetoric** phase learn to express their ideas clearly and persuasively through written and verbal communication. They construct strong arguments and are able to think through both sides of a debate. This process equips students to think critically about their world and to communicate the truth effectively to those around them.
