2019-2020 RHETORIC SCHOOL ELECTIVE COURSE DESCRIPTIONS

ART ELECTIVES

*Art: Drawing I & II: (Monday/Wednesday/Friday)

Drawing: This class will be divided into two groups. Beginning students will be introduced to basic drawing skills including drawing from life, shading, using a grid, seeing shapes, and sighting. Advanced students will be exposed to more advanced techniques utilizing charcoal, colored pencil, pen and ink. Basic drawing supplies will be required. A supply list will be provided on the first day of class.

*Art: Studio Art: (Tuesday/Thursday) Students will have the opportunity to explore various visual art forms and techniques through the elements and principles of art and design. Projects will include drawing, painting, collage, and printmaking. Completed projects will be eligible for submission to various art shows. FEE \$25

*Drama: Production (Audition Required) (Monday/Wednesday/Friday) Rhetoric School drama is a production class by audition only. Auditions are held the first week of school with opportunities in cast, crew, wardrobe and set construction.

*History of Film: (Monday/Wednesday/Friday) History of Film is a class that will begin with a study of the basics of film. The class will focus on evaluating film for its artistic excellence, as well as its thematic ideas – in essence, how each film represents truth, goodness, and beauty.

<u>*Photography</u>: (Tuesday/Thursday) 2nd Semester Only Beginner and intermediate level. Learn how to operate the camera in manual mode and learn to capture the world around you in a beautiful and artistic way.

<u>*Yearbook</u>: (All Year Required - Monday/Wednesday/Friday) Would you like to learn how to zoom, crop or even make your pictures "pop"? Yes! Then yearbook is the place for you. Learn to design, edit and write captions for pictures while learning more about photography.

<u>*3-D Modeling I</u>: (Tuesday/Thursday) 1st Semester Only This course will cover the basics of 3D polygonal modeling. We will be creating both rendered images as well as 3D printing our models. Students are strongly encouraged to bring their own laptops. FEE \$15

*3-D Modeling II: (Tuesday/Thursday) 2nd Semester Only 3D Modeling I is a prerequisite to this course. This course will continue 3D modeling and shading concepts, including advanced shading and physics/fluid simulations. Students are strongly encouraged to bring their own laptops. FEE \$15

MUSIC ELECTIVES

<u>#Band</u>: (Tuesday/Thursday) Concert band for $9^{th} - 12^{th}$ grades taught by Mr. Minor. Auditions are required.

<u>#Chorus</u>: (Tuesday/Thursday) A choral program emphasizing both music theory and performance. Requires purchase of performance attire.

<u>#Music Appreciation</u>: (Monday/Wednesday/Friday) Learn to identify the elements of music and trace the development of the modern day orchestra. Learn about famous composers and listen to examples of their greatest works. Survey the major historical time periods and discuss the unique characteristics found in the music associated with each period.

ACADEMIC ELECTIVES

<u>Current Events</u>: (Tuesday/Thursday) 2nd Semester Only (For 11th & 12th Grade ONLY) Facilitated by Cameron Perkins and Rick Wharton, this elective provides the opportunity to share in open and fun discussions about real topics in the news. World events and currents events such as politics, financial markets, sports, religion, law, and any other topics of interest and debate will all be viable. Students will bring in news articles or videos of choice and help facilitate discussions. Part of the discussion will involve relating the topic to the biblical worldview. Come be a part of this exciting elective.

<u>College Seminar for Seniors</u>: (Tuesday/Thursday) 1st Semester Only Designed to help seniors navigate the college admissions process in its entirety, fine tune resumes, conduct college visits, work on college applications including their essays, explore scholarship oppertunities and make scholarship applications, and practice interviewing. Minimum of 15 seniors needed.

Engineering, Introduction to: (Monday/Wed/Friday) 2nd Semester Only Did you ever wonder what an engineer does? Engineers work in design, manufacturing, and consulting in the world of sports, in the military, and in the arts as well as other areas. In this elective we will learn about different types of engineering (chemical, mechanical, civil, textile, etc.) and the incredible variety of careers that you can have as an engineer. We'll have guest speakers and lots of hands-on activities. Join us and get excited about engineering. FEE \$20

<u>Study Hall</u>: (Monday/Wednesday/Friday & Tuesday/Thursday) Supervised study period recommended for new students, those busy with extracurricular activities, and students who may be struggling a bit academically. The computer lab will not be available to study hall students on a regular basis. Students are encouraged to bring their personal laptops if they need access to a computer during this time.

<u>+Physical Education for Men</u>: (Tuesday/Thursday) Get exercise through various aerobic activities and games.

<u>+Strength/Weight Training for Men: (Monday/Wednesday/Friday)</u> Train with weights to improve or maintain fitness, strength, and endurance.

<u>+Strength/Weight Training for Women</u>: (Tuesday/Thursday) Train with weights to improve or maintain fitness, strength, and endurance.
