2019-2020 ELECTIVE COURSE DESCRIPTIONS



ART ELECTIVES (Fine Art CREDIT)

<u>Art (Monday/ Wednesday/ Friday)</u>: Students will explore the 14 elements and principles of art. They will experiment and refine skills using a variety of art materials. With an emphasis on studio production, this course is designed to develop higher-level thinking, art criticism, art history, and design.

FEE \$25

<u>Art (Tuesday/Thursday)</u>: Students will explore art through a variety of cultures around the world, both past and present. Using a vast array of media, works of art will be created ranging from Egyptian to Aboriginal art. FEE \$25

DRAMA ELECTIVES (Fine Art CREDIT)

Advanced Drama/NCTC: (Monday/Wednesday/Friday) 1st Semester Only (Audition Required) – Beginning Drama is a prerequisite to this class. We build on the foundations that were laid in Beginning Drama and prepare a full production, putting into practice everything the students have learned. FEE \$25

<u>Beginning/Intermediate Drama:</u> (Monday/Wednesday/Friday) 2^{nd} Semester Only – For 7th and 8th grade students who have not been involved in a drama class. We cover the foundations of acting and basic theatre etiquette, creating good habits which students will carry forward. Students learn by participating in theatre games, improvisational exercises, and short scenes.

Foundations of Drama: (Tuesday/Thursday)

2nd Semester Only – For 6th grade students only. Student actors will cultivate their craft through the preparation of multiple monologues and scenes, both dramatic and comedic, from a variety of scripts.

MUSIC ELECTIVES (Music CREDIT)

Band: (Monday/Wednesday/Friday) An intermediate level course of instruction in the brass, woodwind, or percussion instrument of the student's choice. *Students must be taking private lessons.* Preference will be given to students in band the previous year.

Chorus: (Tuesday/Thursday)

This chorus will be just for middle school students. One performance per semester. Join in the creative process of learning to read music and enjoy singing!

Music Appreciation: (Monday/Wednesday/Friday)

Learn to identify the elements of music and trace the development of the modern day orchestra. Learn about famous composers and listen to examples of their greatest works. Survey the major historical time periods and discuss the unique characteristics found in the music associated with each period.

TECHNOLOGY ELECTIVES

Computer Programming Concepts: (Tuesday/Thursday)

This course will introduce computer science programming concepts that introduce tools and programming languages which are accessible for beginners, but which offer plenty of room to grow and create sophisticated projects. FEE \$15

Typing & Computer Software Training:

(Monday/Wednesday/Friday & Tuesday/Thursday) Learn how to type like a pro on the keyboard. Additionally, students will learn how to track their typing progress using Microsoft EXCEL and create a slide presentation using Microsoft PowerPoint.

ACADEMIC ELECTIVES

<u>Chess</u>: (Tuesday/Thursday) Learn to play the game of kings!

Math Help:

(Monday/Wednesday/Friday- 6th -7th-8th) Bring your math problems and we'll help you work them out!

Study Hall: (Monday/Wednesday/Friday & Tuesday/Thursday) Supervised study period recommended for new students and students who are somewhat struggling academically or need time to complete class work.

PHYSICAL EDUCATION ELECTIVE

Boys/Girls Physical Education:

(Monday/Wednesday/Friday & Tuesday/Thursday) Students get plenty of exercise through various plyometrics, aerobic activities and games. Sports include soccer, basketball, and flag football, capture the flag, ultimate frisbee, team dodge ball, castle ball, team handball, grand slam, gauntlet and others! Classes are separated by gender.
