## **Buyer Information**

The uniform sale is **Thursday, May 30th, from 7:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m.** at *Peace Church*. To prepare for your shopping experience, we recommend that you:

- Review the uniform guidelines appropriate for your child which can be found in the Student Handbook on Veracross under resource documents.
- Know what size to buy for your child. See sizing charts at <u>https://www.flynnohara.com</u>. Your child will not be able to try on items during the sale.
- Consider what you will need for the entire school year. When else can you get this selection at these prices?
- Payment must be in cash or check. If paying with cash, please bring small bills (\$10 and under). There will be a \$20 fee for returned checks.
- All sales are final.

## **Seller Information**

By selling your clothing with Re-Threads you will have access to many buyers at a single location, and you will receive 75% of the price for your sold items. In addition, you have the option of picking up your unsold items or donating them. Your check will be mailed to you by June 15th, 2019. There is no minimum or maximum number of items you may consign.

## **Items Accepted**

- CCS uniforms from the current uniform vendor
- CCS uniforms from previous vendors provided they are in good repair and do not have the teal logo
- Other CCS-logoed clothing items from Boosters
- Shoes, tees, belts, and hair bows that meet the uniform guidelines
- CCS football and lacrosse equipment
- Graduation gowns from 2011 or newer

#### **NOT Accepted**

- Teal-logoed items
- Screen-print white logoed sweatshirts
- Old navy/green plaid jumpers or skirts (no white is in plaid)
- Faded, worn out uniform items
- Tights, leggings, socks
- Graduation gowns from 2010 or older

Re-Threads staff has the right to refuse any inappropriate item.

### Pricing

We suggest that clothing in <u>excellent</u> condition be priced at onethird to one-half the original price. Items showing wear should be marked down accordingly. New items with the original tags attached may be priced as you wish. You may look up original prices at the <u>FlynnO'Hara</u> website.

## **Labeling Guidelines**

All items must be tagged prior to being brought to the sale. To tag your items, use half of a  $3^{\circ}x 5^{\circ}$  index card, making your card  $3^{\circ}x 2\frac{1}{2^{\circ}}$ .

White index card if you will be picking up your unsold items.

<u>Colored</u> index card if you would like to donate your unsold items.

Donations will go to the CCS uniform ministry, the SSP (Senior Service Practicum), or other missions ministries.

Re-Threads will tag your items. The tagging fee is 20% of your total sales. If you would like Re-Threads to tag your items, you must schedule an appointment by Sunday, May 19th. Untagged items will not be accepted at Drop Off time.

(Note you do not need an appointment if you are tagging your own items).

In the upper left corner, write your seller ID #. Your ID # is the last 4 digits of your telephone number followed by the first letter of your first and last name. For example, Kim Peele would write 0100KP.

- In the top right corner, write the size. Please estimate if unknown.
- In the center of the tag, write a description of the item.
- If you have altered the garment, please indicate on the tag (e.g., waist taken in, hem let out).
- At the bottom, write the price in full dollar increments. We will round down to the nearest dollar if priced incorrectly.
- Attach the tag securely with a safety pin (hole punching the card first helps) to the upper left corner of the garment (over the heart for tops or over the pocket for pants).
- If a tag falls off an item, we cannot sell the item.
- Hang your items on hangers with the hook facing left, away from the tag (like a question mark).
- Hang pants, shorts, skirts (bottom pieces) with a clip hanger. Your clothing will show better this way.
- Shoes should be connected. We recommend using cable ties.
- Double check your tags for price and code. Do not use straight pins, tape, or other kinds of fasteners. Please write legibly.
- When dropping off your items to sell, group them according to item and size.
- Please bring your items only during the specified drop off time to Peace Church on Thursday, May 30th, from 1:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m.
  - Hangers will be given to buyers and will not be returned to sellers.

## Pick Up

Your unsold items must be picked up on Friday, May 31st, between 8:30 a.m. and 10:30 a.m. at Peace Church. Please arrange to have someone pick up your unsold clothing if you are not available during this time. Unsold items not picked up will be donated. If you plan to donate your unsold items, please indicate this by tagging your items using a colored index card.

Your check will not be available at Pick Up time. It will be mailed to you by June 15th, 2019.
