The early learning program builds a strong foundation by harnessing young children's natural curiosity, fostering a love of learning through exposure to beginning math and language concepts, and, most importantly, instilling a sense of wonder at God's grace, mercy, and role as Creator. The program serves children who are 4 by July 31 with flexible half-and full-day options.

Emphasis in the Little Highlanders classroom focuses on building healthy relationships and confidence, following directions, establishing routines, developing gross and fine motor skills, and introducing the alphabet, math, memory work, discovery-based and hands-on-learning — all in a fun, loving, supportive Christian environment.

Partnering with parents is a strong focus of the program, because children learn best when their parents are actively involved. Families frequently are invited to participate in classroom activities and events. Communication between home and school is maintained regarding the child's participation and development in the program through newsletters, progress reports, and parent-teacher conferences.

ENROLLMENT REQUIREMENTS & PROCESS

- Student must be 4 years old by July 31.
- Student should be potty-trained and able to use the restroom independently or with minimal assistance.
- Parents should have a clear understanding of the biblical philosophy, mission, and vision of Mars Hill Academy and a willingness to have their child taught accordingly.
- Complete Admission Packet, including \$50 application fee. Applicants are encouraged to submit by January 31 to be included in the first round of admission decisions. First round decision letters are mailed at the end of February. Applications received after January 31 will be given consideration as space permits.
- Submit \$50 enrollment fee upon acceptance.
- Parent and new student "Meet and Greet" with Principal James Waldy.
- New student play-based assessment.
