

Standards for Evaluating Prospective Students and Families

- I. Spiritual Considerations
 - A. Personal Christian commitment of parents and student and involvement in a local church
 - B. Willingness of parents and student to be supportive of the school's Christian philosophy of education
 - C. Willingness of parents and student to support the administration and faculty in carrying out the goals and programs of the school
 - D. Willingness of parents and student to practice biblical communication when resolving conflicts and otherwise interacting with others in the community
- II. Behavioral Considerations

- A. History of acceptable citizenship in previous school experience
- B. Agreement of parents and student to abide by the behavior standards established by the school
- C. Willingness of parents to read required materials
- D. Understanding of school's discipline philosophies and willingness of parents to embrace those policies in the home
- III. Academic Considerations
 - A. Documented record of acceptable grades in previous school experience
 - B. Acceptable scores on entrance tests
 - C. Academic preparedness for requested grade level
- IV. Personal Considerations
 - A. Student's special interests, talents, and skills
 - B. Student's level of intellectual curiosity

Admissions Timeline

December 19, 2019

Sibling applications due (Testing and supporting documents due February 1, 2020)

Qualified siblings of PCS students in good standing receive priority consideration when their applications and required forms are received by the due dates.

January 31, 2020

Re-enrollment Due for Current Families

February 1, 2020

New family applications due

Priority consideration is given to families who submit applications on or before February 1, 2020

After February 1, 2020

Applications will be considered on a rolling basis as space allows.

February 28, 2020

Financial Aid applications due

Applications received after this date will only be considered for limited remaining financial aid funds.

March 31, 2020

Deadline for communicating Financial Aid and Admissions priority decisions to families who met the initial deadlines.
