Subject/Unit: 10th Greek

Week 11 (Nov 1-5)

Introduction: Gain and train student interest. Review: Unknown is explained by means of the known.

- Greek Grammar Chant

Lesson: Common language so that the student is a discoverer.

Monday – Review 20 Greek words from previous chapters (students write the English meaning)

- Introduce and discuss ch 11 vocabulary
- Discuss the personal pronoun in English
- Discuss and take notes on the 1st and 2nd person pronoun in Greek
- Check Drew's review sheets and grade

Tuesday – Review same 20 Greek words (students write the English meaning)

- Practice declining the Greek 1st and 2nd person pronouns (ἐγώ and σύ)
- Read and discuss characteristics of the Greek pronoun
- Parsing exercises from workbook in groups
- Give study guide for quiz on Friday

Wednesday – Review same 20 Greek words (students write the Greek word)

- Decline ἐγώ and σύ on whiteboards
- Warm-up translation exercises from workbook as a class
- HW: 1st, 2nd, 3rd declension review worksheet

Thursday – Review same 20 Greek words (students write the Greek word)

- Decline λόγος, ὥρα, and σάββας on whiteboards
- Discuss nouns exceptions in the 3rd declension
- Translation exercises from workbook in groups

Friday – Quiz over 20 Greek words and over 1st, 2nd, and 3rd declension nouns

- Study ch 11 and 12 vocabulary with flashcards/quizlets

Assessment: Require student to reproduce in his own language

- Quiz over 20 Greek words and over 1st, 2nd, and 3rd declension nouns (Fri)
- Warm-up and translation exercises from workbook
