<p>Introduction: Gain and train student interest. <p>Lesson: Common language so that the student is a discoverer.</p> <p>-One on one feedback -For those who finish early – Write a short paragraph about their artwork</p>	
<p>Assessment: Require student to reproduce in his own language</p> <p>-Practice creating value in their artwork by using different pencil grades and hand pressure.</p>
