Respect

- Do this as a class.
- We will be purposely polite.
- We will be silent in the halls.
- We will use the interrupt rule.
- We will greet our guests.
- We will use self-control in our words and actions.

- We will use our inside voice at lunch.
- We will not tattle (Did it hurt you or damage property?)
- You may report.
