**Quadrant Perspective** 



The Seven Laws of Teaching – by John Milton Gregory ("KICKERR")

- 1. Law of the Teacher: The teacher must thoroughly <u>know</u> the lesson content.
- 2. Law of the Learner: The learner must attend with <u>interest</u> to the lesson.
- 3. Law of the Language: The language used in the lesson must be <u>common</u> to teacher and learner.
- 4. Law of the Lesson: The new content of the lesson must be learned through content already <u>known</u> by the learner.
- 5. Law of the Teaching Process: Excite and direct the self-activities of the learner and tell him nothing that he can learn himself.
- 6. Law of the Learning Process: The learner must <u>reproduce</u> the lesson in his own mind.
- 7. Law of Review: The completion, test, and confirmation of teaching must be made by <u>reviews</u>.
